

Spring 2021 (202106) Persistence Report (formerly known as Retention Report)**January 16, 2021**

The Persistence Report (formerly known as the Retention Report) contains information about students that were enrolled in the Fall 2020 (202103) term at JWCC and tracks them into the Spring 2021 (202106) term. The report contains information about those students that the College retained, completed a degree or certificate, transferred to another institution, or stopped/dropped out.

The data below are based on two different groups. In the first set of numbers, the base includes all degree/certificate-seeking, college-level students (adult ed and high school students are excluded). The second set of numbers is based on the same group as above, but students who either completed their degree/certificate or transferred are excluded. It is important to note that the first set of numbers are duplicated (i.e., if a student completed their degree and transferred to another institution, the student will be counted in both categories).

- Fall 2020 Unduplicated Headcount: 1,555¹
 - Completed a degree or certificate in Fall 2021: 113 (23%)
 - Returning students in Fall 2021: 1097 (53%)
 - Transferred to another institution in Fall 2021: 37 (14%)
 - Spring 2020 students that did not complete, return, or transfer (Stop/Drop-Outs): 358 (22%)
 - 917 Female Students (60%)
 - 570 Male Students (36%)
 - 67 Students listed as N (4%)
 - 863 Full-Time Students (50%)
 - 691 Part-Time Students (50%)
- Spring 2020 Retention Cohort Headcount: 1,412²
 - Returned in Fall 2021 (Cohort Retention Rate): 1054 (75%)
 - Did not return in Fall 2021: 358 (25%)

¹This headcount does not include students enrolled in adult education credit courses, non-degree/certificate-seeking students, or high school students.

²This headcount does not include students enrolled in adult education credit courses, non-degree/certificate-seeking students, or high school students. Students who completed their degree/certificate in the spring or transferred to another institution in the fall are also excluded as they have already fulfilled their objective.
