**Dual credit** . . . in our dual enrollment program, you will continue to be homeschooled, but you can also earn college credit at the same time by enrolling in JWCC online classes for college credit. There are many opportunities available, even in math and lab sciences. Taking college courses will add affordable enrichment, increasing your knowledge and ability and adding to the benefits that you already receive through your education at home.

**College degree completion** . . . through our TriState Online Consortium you will have access to a number of online courses which can provide the opportunity to continue a self-directed style of study, while introducing college-level curriculum. Through JWCC's Online Degree Completion program it is possible to finish a degree online (with the exception of Speech).

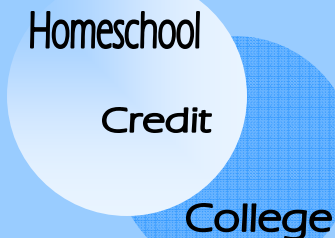
### HOW TO ENROLL

#### **Dual Credit**

- Submit a letter from your school administrator (or homeschool parent) stating that you are permitted to take classes.

#### **Degree Completion**

- Have official high school transcripts, GED scores, or any prior college transcripts sent to the JWCC Admissions Office.
- Complete COMPASS™ placement testing or have appropriate prior college credit or ACT exam scores available to ease your placement into math and English courses.

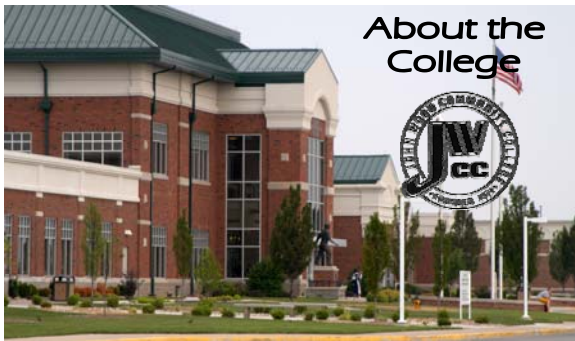

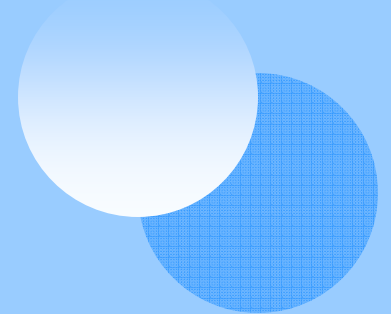
