- \$65 = Credential Occupational Safety and Health Administration and MSSC Manufacturing Safety Through course completion a student may receive two nationally recognized credentials. These benefit a student when seeking employment confirming they have completed the necessary training that provide workers with safety and manufacturing skills.

Students are responsible for fees associated with classes.

- Tuition fee is \$100 per course;
- Book purchases [MFG 113 (MSCC/OSHA) = \$52; MAT 100–ALEKS online software access = \$107]

Students who have successfully completed a course with a grade of “C” or better may redeem for credit if the following are met:

- Must present a copy of the Certificate of Completion within one year of high school graduation date to receive credit to the JWCC Records & Registration Office;
- Student must be admitted to a JWCC program requiring coursework of MFG 113 and/or MAT 100. Course must go towards the student’s declared program of study.

If above criteria is met then three credits will be given for MFG 113 and/or MAT 100.

* Community-Based Outreach Courses (non-credit) The following courses are offered as non-credit. These courses are required for the majority of Career Technical Programs at JWCC. The student may request credit to be awarded within one year of the high school graduation date if they are seeking admission to JWCC. To receive credit, the student must provide a copy of the final “completion certificate” to the JWCC Registrar’s Office prior first registration and within the one year limitation after the high school graduation date.
