**Brad Hoyt** has 16 years of college coaching experience. Coach Hoyt is currently the Athletic Director/Head Men's Basketball Coach at John Wood CC. Coach Hoyt has been a head coach at the NAIA and the NJCAA level. During Coach Hoyt's eight-year tenure as the head men's basketball coach at John Wood

Community College his overall record is 161-98. Over the course of the past five seasons, the Trail Blazers have won three conference championships, two Region 24 tournament titles, and two trips to the NJCAA DII National Tournament. In 2015, the Trail Blazers finished as the NJCAA DII National Runner Up, falling in the National Championship game. In those previous five seasons, the Trail Blazers have had ten All-Region selections, including three Players of the Year in both the Region and the Conference, three Freshmen of the Year selections, as well as three First Team All-Americans. Coach Hoyt has been named the Coach of the Year in Region 24, in the Mid West Athletic Conference, and by the Illinois Basketball Coaches Association multiple times.
