FAQS

Q: Who is eligible to enroll in Smart Start 2x2?

A: Any high school student of junior or senior status can enroll. Acceptance into the program will be based on recommendation from the high school guidance counselor or principle, parent/guardian approval, and GPA and entrance scores on Accuplacer or ACT/ SAT exams.

Q: How do I apply?

A: High school students will work with their high school guidance counselor and John Wood liaison to complete the application and make sure all requirements have been met.

Q: What is the cost?

A: Cost per credit hour for a course at the high school or on John Wood's campus is \$160. Cost per credit hour for an online course is \$190. *(Cost subject to change. Rates are set by board by June 2018 for Fall 2018 semester)*

Q: What will the student be required to pay?

A: The student will be responsible for tuition, fees (depending on course), and books not already provided by the high school.

Q: Are there scholarships available?

A: Yes, there are scholarships available. Availability does depend on the high school the student is attending.



Q: I have taken AP course while in high school, can I receive college credit for those courses?


A: AP credit will be awarded after the student has completed six credit hours within the Accelerate College Program. The student must score a 3 or higher on the final AP exam.

Q: When I graduate high school, will I have an Associate Degree?

A: If the student was of junior status taking two 8-week courses every 8 weeks for two years, the student would complete the 64 credit hour requirement for an Associate Degree. JWCC courses and degrees transfer nationwide. Students will work with an advisor throughout the program.
