Financial Requirement for Applicants with F-1 student Visas

Under current Immigration and Naturalization Service regulation, international students must provide evidence of sufficient financial resources to support all their living and educational expenses during their stay in the United States. In order to receive financial approval for admission and a Form I-20, an applicant must complete the Financial Form and provide all required documents to verify that sufficient funds are immediately available. The College reserves the right to require tuition deposits, if deemed necessary. These figures do not include travel expenses. Students should anticipate an annual increase of five to seven percent due to inflation and other factors. Please note that the Financial Form and proper financial verification, no older than 3 months, must be provided for financial clearance to be processed. The reference to "Bank Statement" or "Bank Verification" in the form means that the financial institution holding the source of funds must provide a statement indicating the amount available in U.S. currency. If necessary, multiple bank statements may be provided to verify available funds.
