## Spring 2016 (201606) Retention Report June 2, 2016

The Retention Report contains information about students that were enrolled in the fall 2015 (201603) term at JWCC and tracks them into the spring 2016 (201606) term. The report contains information about those students that the College retained, completed a degree or certificate, transferred to another institution, or stopped/dropped out.

The data below are based on two different groups. In the first set of numbers, the base includes all degree/certificate-seeking, college-level students (adult ed and high school students are excluded). The second set of numbers is based on the same group as above, but students who either completed their degree/certificate or transferred are excluded. It is important to note that the first set of numbers are duplicated (i.e., if a student completed their degree and transferred to another institution, the student will be counted in both categories).

- Fall 2015 Unduplicated Headcount: 1,721<sup>1</sup>
  - o Completed a degree or certificate in fall 2015: 91 (5%)
  - o Returning students in spring 2015: 1213 (70%)
  - o Transferred to another institution in spring 2015: 68 (4%)
  - o Fall 2015 students that did not complete, return, or transfer (Stop/Drop-Outs): 382 (22%)
- Fall 2015 Retention Cohort Headcount: 1,572<sup>2</sup>
  - o Returned in spring 2015 (Cohort Retention Rate): 1190 (76%)
  - Did not return in spring 2015: 382 (24%)
