Spring 2018 (201806) Retention Report July 16, 2018

The Retention Report contains information about students that were enrolled in the fall 2017 (201803) term at JWCC and tracks them into the spring 2018 (201806) term. The report contains information about those students that the College retained, completed a degree or certificate, transferred to another institution, or stopped/dropped out.

The data below are based on two different groups. In the first set of numbers, the base includes all degree/certificate-seeking, college-level students (adult ed and high school students are excluded). The second set of numbers is based on the same group as above, but students who either completed their degree/certificate or transferred are excluded. It is important to note that the first set of numbers are duplicated (i.e., if a student completed their degree and transferred to another institution, the student will be counted in both categories).

 - Completed a degree or certificate in fall 2017: 104 (7%)
 - o Returning students in spring 2018: 1119 (74%)
 - Transferred to another institution in spring 2018: 44 (3%)

- Fall 2017 Retention Cohort Headcount: 1,377²
 - o Returned in spring 2018 (Cohort Retention Rate): 1091 (79%)
