Type of Work

Clean and bathe patients and residents. Turn, reposition, and transfer patients between beds and wheelchairs, Listen to and record patients' health concerns and report that information to nurses. Measure patients' vital signs. Serve meals and help patients eat.

Certified Nursing Assistant REQUIRED COURSES

The curriculum requires 120 hours of theory in the classroom and 48 hours of clinical experience. The course time is divided between classroom teaching, laboratory demonstration and practice, and supervised clinical practice in a local nursing home. This course includes CPR for the Healthcare Provider.
