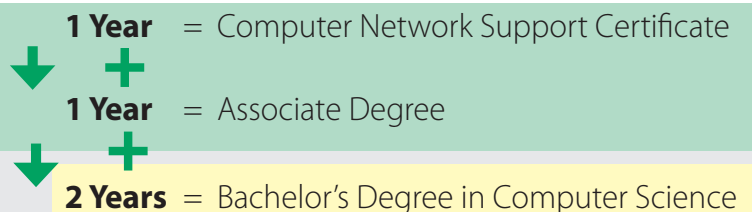


### Type of Work

Computer network support specialists, also called technical support specialists, analyze, troubleshoot, and evaluate computer network problems. They play an important role in the routine maintenance of their organization's networks, such as performing file backups on the network. Maintenance can be performed daily, weekly, or monthly. They also troubleshoot local area networks (LANs), wide area networks (WANs) and Internet systems.

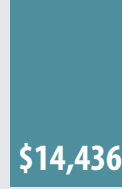
