Type of Work

Assess injuries, administer emergency medical care, and extricate trapped individuals. Transport injured or sick persons to medical facilities. Administer first aid treatment or life support care to sick or injured persons in pre-hospital settings. Perform emergency diagnostic and treatment procedures. Assess nature and extent of illness or injury to establish and prioritize medical procedures.

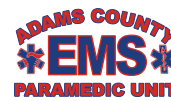
