### Type of Work

Psychologists study emotional, and social processes and behavior by observing, interpreting, and recording how individuals relate to one another and to their environments. Some psychologists work independently, conducting research, consulting with clients, or working with patients. Others work as part of a healthcare team, collaborating with physicians and social workers, or in school settings, working with students, teachers, parents, and other educators. Psychology majors use their skills in business and not-for-profit careers.

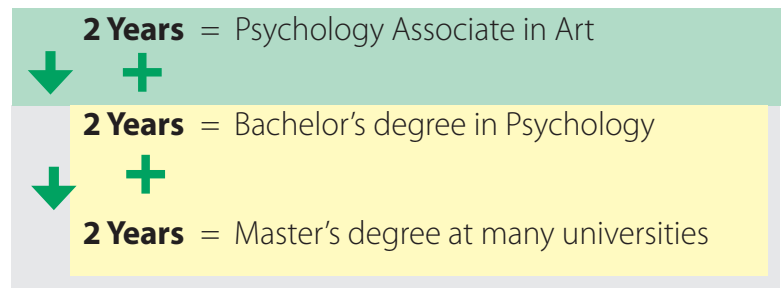
