### Type of Work

Check vehicles to ensure mechanical, safety, and emergency equipment is in good working order. Follow appropriate safety procedures for transporting dangerous goods. Inspect loads to ensure the cargo is secure. Maintain logs of working hours, vehicle service or repair status and follow applicable state and federal regulations. Secure cargo for transport, using ropes, blocks, chain, binders or covers.

## PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Be at least 21 years of age (or 18 with program approval)
- Possess a valid driver's license
- Pass a standard Department of Transportation physical, administered by a DOT-qualified physician selected by JWCC
- Pass a drug screen, as required by federal law
- Have a safe driving record, with no recent alcohol or drug-related offenses.

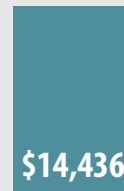
