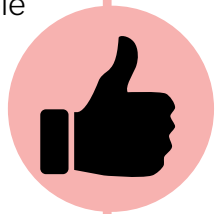
Year 3 students will continue preparing for the job search and successful employment.

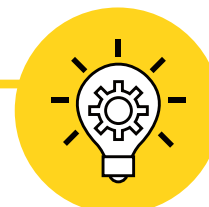


PROBLEM SOLVING: ENGINEERING
