

## Begin your career path before graduating high school!

Certified nursing assistants (CNAs) are prepared to provide one-on-one assistance with "activities of daily living" (ADLs), defined as dressing, bathing, walking, feeding, making beds, taking and recording vital signs, and other essential basic services. This care may be provided to hospital patients, care facility residents, or those requiring home healthcare.



### **BASIC NURSE ASSISTANT**


Theoretical and clinical foundation for skills needed to practice as a nursing assistant with introduction to nutrition, anatomy and physiology, and disease processes.



### NURSING ASSISTANT PRACTICUM

Introduction to the clinical setting with supervised practice of basic patient care. Focus on application of principles of patient care skills and developing competencies in the long-term care setting.
