STEP TWO

NURSING PROGRAM APPLICATION

- 1) Apply to JWCC Admission
- 2) Apply to ADN program:
 - a) Must meet minimum 2.7 GPA
 - b) Must meet ACT or SAT, and/or HESI A2 Admissions Assessment Test scoresAdditional info at: jwcc.edu/nursing

STEP THREE

ADN COMPLETION TRACK

- Option #1: COMPLETE YEAR ONE** of Nursing courses + NUR 190 to prepare for the NCLEX-PN to become a Practical Nurse (LPN).
- Option #2: COMPLETE YEAR TWO** of nursing courses to earn an Associate Degree in Nursing and prepare to take NCLEX-RN Exam to become a Registered Nurse (RN).
- Option #3: Continuing Education:** Transfer to a 4-year university to earn a Bachelor of Nursing Degree and beyond!
