

**Spring 2022 (202206) Persistence Report (formerly known as Retention Report)****May 17, 2022**

The Persistence Report (formerly known as the Retention Report) contains information about students that were enrolled in the Fall 2021 (202203) term at JWCC and tracks them into the Spring 2022 (202206) term. The report contains information about those students that the College retained, completed a degree or certificate, transferred to another institution, or stopped/dropped out.

The data below are based on two different groups. In the first set of numbers, the base includes all degree/certificate-seeking, college-level students (adult ed and high school students are excluded). The second set of numbers is based on the same group as above, but students who either completed their degree/certificate or transferred are excluded. It is important to note that the first set of numbers are duplicated (i.e., if a student completed their degree and transferred to another institution, the student will be counted in both categories).

- Spring 2022 Unduplicated Headcount: 1,430<sup>1</sup>
  - Completed a degree or certificate in Spring 2021 or Summer 2021: 109 (18%)
  - Returning students in Fall 2021: 1003 (50%)
  - Transferred to another institution in Fall 2021: 35 (15%)
  - Spring 2020 students that did not complete, return, or transfer (Stop/Drop-Outs): 268 (25%)
  - 857 Female Students (60%)
  - 526 Male Students (36%)
  - 46 Students listed as N (4%)
  - 782 Full-Time Students (50%)
  - 647 Part-Time Students (50%)
  - 20 students listed as Asian (1%)
  - 16 Students listed as American Indian or Alaskan (2%)
  - 98 students listed as Black or African American (7%)
  - 1293 students listed as White (90%)
  - 4 students listed as Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander (>1%)
- Spring 2022 Retention Cohort Headcount: 1,296<sup>2</sup>
  - Returned in Fall 2021 (Cohort Retention Rate): 978 (65%)
  - Did not return in Fall 2021: 318 (35%)
