

Spring 2023 (202306) Persistence Report (formerly known as Retention Report)**September 19, 2023**

The Persistence Report (formerly known as the Retention Report) contains information about students that were enrolled in the Fall 2022 (202303) term at JWCC and tracks them into the Spring 2023 (202306) term. The report contains information about those students that the College retained, completed a degree or certificate, transferred to another institution, or stopped/dropped out.

The data below are based on two different groups. In the first set of numbers, the base includes all degree/certificate-seeking, college-level students (adult ed and high school students are excluded). The second set of numbers is based on the same group as above, but students who either completed their degree/certificate or transferred are excluded. It is important to note that the first set of numbers are duplicated (i.e., if a student completed their degree and transferred to another institution, the student will be counted in both categories).

 - Completed a degree or certificate in Fall 2022: 110 (7.91%)
 - Returning students in Fall 2022: 909 (65.40%)
 - Transferred to another institution in Fall 2022: 122 (8.78%)
 - Spring 2022 students that did not complete, return, or transfer (Stop): 302 (21.73%)
 - 837 Female Students (60.22%)
 - 513 Male Students (36.91%)
 - 40 Students listed as N (2.88%)
 - 742 Full-Time Students (53.38%)
