

**Fall 2024 (202503) Persistence Report (formerly known as Retention Report)
January 31, 2024**

The Persistence Report (formerly known as the Retention Report) contains information about students that were enrolled in the Spring 2024 (202406) term at JWCC and tracks them into the Fall 2024 (202503) term. The report contains information about those students that the College retained, completed a degree or certificate, transferred to another institution, or stopped/dropped out.
