

**Spring 2024 (202406) Persistence Report (formerly known as Retention Report)****June 21, 2024**

The Persistence Report (formerly known as the Retention Report) contains information about students that were enrolled in the Fall 2023 (202403) term at JWCC and tracks them into the Spring 2024 (202406) term. The report contains information about those students that the College retained, completed a degree or certificate, transferred to another institution, or stopped/dropped out.

  - Completed a degree or certificate in Fall 2023: 113 (8.53%)
  - Returning students in Spring 2024: 1032 (75.21%)
