IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- The degree outline on reverse assumes that the student places into college-level reading, writing, and math.
- STEM and Education majors are required to take 3 additional math credits, 3 additional science credits, 3 less social science credits and 3 less humanities credits.
- Education majors should take science classes that have labs (= 4+ credit hours).
- Math and English are interchangeable between Junior and Senior year depending on the needs of the high school and student progress toward graduation.
- Individual high schools may suggest specific general education electives if they offer them through the high school.
- All associate degrees from JWCC do require an International Awareness course – Choose from: CHN 101, CHN 102, ENG 241, ENG 251, HIS 101, HIS 102, HIS 111, HIS 112, HUM 200, PHL 201, SOC 222, ART 115, DRA 103, ENG 242, HUM 121, MUS 102, MUS 121.
