**Begin your career path before graduating high school!**

The TDT certificate prepares students for the CDL examination, leading to employment as Class A truck drivers. Students gain in-depth knowledge and hands-on experience in properly operating Class A trucks. This program offers students the opportunity to attain a stackable college credential toward an AAS degree in Logistics and Operations Management. JWCC uses industry standard equipment for training and employs the latest technology.



### INTRO TO TRUCK DRIVER TRAINING

This course provides an overview of vehicle braking and electrical, mechanical, and air systems, as well as D.O.T. rules and regulations. Successful completion of this course will prepare the student to obtain a Commercial Driver's License (CDL) Learner's Permit.



### TRUCK DRIVER TRAINING FUNDAMENTALS

This course provides an overview of truck transportation, description of truck systems and how they work, and basic defensive driving skills. Additional topics include learning safe driving practices and correct cargo securement.



### TRUCK DRIVER TRAINING OPERATIONS

This course provides extensive hands-on experience in backing, parking, start-up, preventive maintenance, and over the road driving. Successful completion will allow the student to take necessary skills testing to obtain a Class A CDL.
